Returning Your Vote-by-Mail Ballot By Mail

- One Forever Stamp or \$.60 postage
- If returning by mail, the US Postal Service suggests mailing your vote-by-mail ballot **no later than Tues., Aug. 16** (one week prior to election day)
- Vote-by-mail ballots must be received by 7 p.m. election day (Tues., Aug. 23) to be counted



Returning Your Vote-by-Mail Ballot In Person

Drop Off Ballot Inside Any Sarasota County Elections Office July 14 - Aug. 23

- July 14 - Aug. 12, during regular business hours, M-F, 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
- Aug. 13 - 22 daily (including weekends), 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
- Aug. 23 (election day), 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

VOTE-BY-MAIL CHECKLIST



Sign the Voter's Certificate



Sign your name on the Voter's Certificate on the pre-addressed return envelope.

Also write the date on the line provided.



Voluntarily Provide Contact Information



Below the voter's signature line is space to provide your email address or phone number. Voluntarily providing this information makes contacting you easier if there is a question about your vote-by-mail ballot signature.



Apply Proper Postage



If returning your ballot by mail, place one Forever Stamp or \$.60 postage on the return envelope.



Return Your Ballot Three Ways



1. **Mail your ballot early** to avoid postal delays so it arrives by 7 p.m. election day, or
2. Drop off your ballot at any **early voting location** (see page 1 or visit our [Early Voting](#) page for details), or
3. Drop off your ballot at the **elections office** by 7 p.m. on election day to be counted.
